NVAL GALLERY SHOWS - DISPLAY YOUR ARTWORK

NVAL supports local artists both professional and less experienced alike by displaying their original artwork in our monthly Member Shows. All members are encouraged to participate. Art can be for sale or display only (NFS). A 20% commission applies to items sold. The League sponsors several juried shows. Recent shows include the National Painting Show featuring painters' art from throughout the United States, the North State Painting Show showcasing regional artists, and the Regional Photography Show exhibiting work of photographers from northern California and southern Oregon. Details for all these shows and receptions are announced in the Newsletter and on the NVAL website nval.org.

EXHIBITS at REDDING CITY HALL - NVAL is assisting the City of Redding by providing artwork for four, three-month shows per year at the Redding City Hall allowing more exhibiting opportunities for NVAL members.

MEMBERSHIP DUES

Thank you for your membership! NVAL membership dues are paid annually from the date that you last paid.

ARTWORK EXHIBITING POLICY The Exhibit Installation Committee wants to accommodate the maximum number of artworks and artists that will aesthetically fit in the gallery. The overall effect and space available determine the placement of artwork in any show. No one artist's work is given preference.

If a large number of works are entered in any member show, the following criteria will be used to determine which pieces will be exhibited. Pieces in the order listed by the artist will be accepted in that order; for example, if there is insufficient space, only the first piece listed will be installed. If space permits, more pieces will be installed in the order listed.

The NVAL Board has adopted the following policies which are standard with regional non-profit galleries. They are stated below.

- 1. The North Valley Art League shall not be responsible for, and assumes no Liability arising from fire, theft, damage or loss to ARTIST's property, including without limitation, the displayed artwork or any other items. ARTIST hereby releases and discharges the North Valley Art League from all claims and demands by ARTIST for loss of or damage to ARTIST's property.
- 2. The ARTIST further agrees that the North Valley Art League may use digital images of the ARTIST's original artwork for promotion of the art exhibit and the North Valley Art League.

REQUIREMENTS TO EXHIBIT YOUR WORK

- Membership dues must be up-to-date.
- All artwork must be original. Photographs and digital art are considered original work. Prints can be displayed in the gift shop, although they must be approved by the Gift Shop Committee. (See Gift Shop Section below).
- Hanging fees are \$5 per piece and are not refundable.
- All paintings and photographs must be ready to hang. Framing must be substantial and up to typical gallery standards (no poster frames).
- Frames need to be properly fitted with D-rings or split rings that fit our hanging system (½ inch to ¾ inch).
- Eye hooks are NOT acceptable.
- D-rings can be purchased at NVAL 2 for \$1. They are also available at hardware stores, Home Depot, Lowe's etc.
- D-Rings and Split Rings Positioning:





For most pieces, place D-rings 2" from top of the frame to prevent the frame from leaning away from the wall at the top. With large pieces 3" from the top works well. Please do not use hanging hardware centered on the top of the frame to hang your work. The piece will be unstable when hung.

GIFT SHOP NVAL maintains a gift shop at the Carter House Gallery that features gift art created by members including quality prints of members' original works. Contact the gift shop committee chairperson if interested in selling your work in the Gift Shop. The Gift Shop Committee is always looking for new artists to showcase their work in the shop. Items are rotated. A 20% commission applies to items sold.
